New Business:

- Sullivan County Youth Book Festival

    - Concerns were voiced over using the money for the tent, which is over \$5,000 this year
  - SUPLA may partner with the Sullivan County Community College to host future festivals to avoid the tent issue

    - Would need volunteers to set up, run, and take down (approximately 9:00am-4:00pm on Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>; the festival itself is 10:00am-3:00pm)

  - Mary Paige is in touch with the Academy of Finance through the high school, who has a point person to help organize teen volunteers
